No. 1 Coeruleum Hue
No. 2 Ultramarine Blue Dark
No. 3 Mix Cadmium Yellow and Cadmium Red (ratio 2:1)
No. 4 Cadmium Yellow

No. 5 Alizarin Crimson Hue
No. 6 Sap Green
No. 7 Purple Lake
No. 8 Mix Sap Green and Hooker's Green Dark

STEP



Define the working area with masking tape. Wash the upper part of the painting with clean water and add colors No. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5. Once it's done, wash the bottom part of the painting and add color No. 6 and No. 7. Then, on a still wet layer paint lavender branches with colors No. 6 and No. 7. Allow the painting to dry completely.

STEP



Now, paint lavender branches more clearly with colors No. 6 and No. 7. Note: I advise to start to paint with stems of the lavender firstly and then add lavender flowers. Allow the layer to dry.

STEP



Now, paint leaves with color No. 8. Optional: add some additional lavender's branches with colors No. 6 and No. 7. Add splattering with color No. 7.
